REQUIREMENTS OF ADMISSION:

Any student have obtaining Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Arts, Commerce, Science, Home Sciences, Pharmacology, B.Ed., B.P.Ed. & Law Graduates of this or a 'Degree of another University recognized as equivalent there to is eligible for admission., Admission procedure of MSW shall be followed-as per Nagpur University Ordinance No. 125.

Candidate appeared for graduations (Final) Examination are also eligible to appear for the procedure of MSW Semester Pattern Course. The Graduates who have specialized in Social Work Sociology, Psychology, Economics and Anthropology will give preference in admission.

IDENTITY CARD:

- a) Every Student of the Institute must have an identity card, It should be always carried on person within and outside the institute and should produce it whenever called upon to the concerned authorities. No student of the institute should travel without his/her Identity Card. This card shall be produced at the time of University examination by every candidate appearing for the examination.
- b) An Identity card will be issued to every student after admission with their recent photograph in the prescribed size is required. In case it is lost, a new Identity card will be issued on payment of Rs. 25/- to the Institute office.

ATTENDANCE:

- a) According to the rules prescribed by the R.T.M. University Nagpur, the curricular and extracurricular activities are compulsory. - b) The exact due dates for the payment of fees for the second session will be notified on the Institute's notice board failure to pay the fees within the notified period will make a students liable to pay a fine, permission for late payment of fees should be obtained from the Principal before the expiry of the last date notified
- A fine of rupee one per day will be payable after the stipulated date for payment, c) for delay in payment up to one month beyond that the admission/studentship is liable to be cancelled.

d) Student entitled for any of the government concessions fees student should fill up form and submit within eight days in the office for their government's concessions fees from the date of their admission. It is the duty of the students to read notice in time. Applications received late or incomplete will not be entertained by the institute office.

■ REFUND OF FEES / DEPOSITS :

a) Fee once paid are not refundable.

OR

Refunded as per UGC/University rules.

■ VILLAGE CAMP:

- A) The village camp will be a residential camp in a village.
- B) Through the camp the students shall learn about:
 - i) Problems of health, education, sanitation, drinking water, environmental degradation etc. in rural area.
 - ii) The problems of agriculture, cropping and the role of technology in rural development.

Adjustability in camp/community life.

- iii) Development of skills in community contact.
- iv) The Government Programmes working in the villages.
- v) Social satisfaction related to Woman/Schedule Caste/ Tribes and the land less labours.
- C) The student participating in the camp shall organise programme to provide information and create awareness about rural problems and solutions. Recreational and cultural programmes can also be under taken involving village youths, children & women. Some programmes organized for the village community.

Village camp (Compulsory) for students of M.S.W. which will be arranged in the second or third week of Feb./March. The village Camp fee is to be paid at the time of admission.

EXAMINATION FEES :

The Annual Examination Fee payable to the R.T.M. Nagpur University in the first week of January. B.S.W. - I, II, III, IV, V, VI, M.S.W. I, II, III, IV Semester.

STUDY TOUR:

Study Tour is compulsory for every students of M.S.W. IV Semester. Tour will be arranged in the month of Feb./March. The amount of study four fees is to be paid at the time of admission and difference of actual expenses will recover from student.

LIBRARY DEPOSIT:

Every student has to pay deposit Rs. 200/- to make use of Library.

NOTE: Library deposit of Rs. 200/- will be returned only when the student completes or discontinues her/his studies and fulfillment of regular office procedure.

RESEARCH DISSERTATION BASED ON SPECIALIZATION

In addition to theory papers and Social Work Practicum each student shall be required to undertake an independent research work and prepare a dissertation based on primary data, during the 3rd Semester. The topic of such research dissertation shall be relevant to the specialization group opted by the student. The topic of such research dissertation shall be finalized only after the University approval.

Each student shall be supervised in their research dissertation by an approved faculty member from the affiliated Institute/College. No faculty member shall be permitted to supervise more than ten (10) MSW students in their research dissertation in an academic year. Periodic individual conference, related to research dissertation of each student shall be conducted by the research supervisor. The supervisor may also conduct group conference of students placed under his/her supervision.

Each student shall be required to take part in Class Room Presentations in the context of research dissertation. Assignments regarding such presentations shall be related to the research methodology and tools of research being developed by the student. The student who fails to take part in such classroom presentations shall forfeit the marks earmarked for such activity.

Such dissertation shall be based on quantitative research methods. However, a mixedmethod approach, making use of both quantitative and qualitative data may also be permissible. The sample size for quantitative research shall not be less than 60 respondents. Not less than 180 hours shall be spent by the student for such research dissertation. A total of 6 Credits shall be allocated to Research Dissertation during the 3rd Semester of the two-year Master of Social Work Course.

A minimum of 5 grade points, which is equivalent to 'E' grade, shall be required for passing Research Dissertation. Independent passing in Research Dissertation is mandatory for passing the 3rd Semester. Those who fail in Research Dissertation shall be required to repeat and pass Research Dissertation, before being promoted to the 4th Semester.

It shall be mandatory for each student to appear for an Internal and External Viva Voce in Research Dissertation during the 3rd Semester. Such external viva voce shall be conducted by an external examiner who is appointed by the University. A student who fails to appear for the external viva voce shall not be eligible to pass the 3rd Semester.

FIELD WORK:

Field work is organized as concurrent field work and unit field work where observation and orientation visits are arranged prior to routine field work & students participation in such visits orientation visits are arranged prior to routine field work & students participation is compulsory. Students required to keep a diary and journal of the field work done during the course of their study information regarding the units, of the study and field of work agencies would be notified from time to time. Journals will be issued to students whenever required and annual fees of Rs. 150/- will be charged.

PROJECT REPORT:

A major consideration in the project requirement is its educational value. It offers students an opportunity to collect data in the special field under the guidance of faculty members and to familiarize themselves with methods of research. The special guidance in the connection will be arranged and offered. Universities last date of submission of Project Report is 15th Feb. every year. It if fails it is not the responsibility of the college. A copy of the detailed rules governing research projects may be obtained from the office.

SEMINARS AND GROUP DISCUSSION

Students will take up selected topics for seminar and group discussion. The time alloted will be about 45 minutes. An assessment of the candidate is made on the basis of how he expresses himself, how he is able to relate himself to the group and how far is he able to make a contribution to the discussion.

Block Placement (Internship):

MSW Students are encouraged to undertake Optional Block Placement (Internship) of one month duration. Internship is one of the components of social work practicum, wherein after completion of the required field work, an opportunity is provided to learner to strengthen his/her skill and knowledge base in his/her area of interest. It is also designed to give an experience of a job situation of short duration (one month) to students in a range of organizations.

The student shall be place in an agency of their choice, which could be a non-government organization, government organization, social movement, or advocacy group depending upon the students' choice as possible, after they complete the 4th Semester. There shall be no credits awarded for such Block Placement (Internship). However, it shall be obligatory on the part of the college, where the student is pursuing his/her studies, to issue a certificate to those students who successfully complete such Block Placement (Internship) to that effect, provided the student produces such internship completion certificate which is issued by the agency.

JOB PLACEMENT:

- Career Counseling is provided to students.
- Campus interviews are arranged through a Job Placement Cell.

ALUMNI-RELATED ACTIVITIES:

- Registered and functioning of an active alumni association.
- The work profile of alumni is maintained.
- Alumni directory and an alumni newsletter are used media for communication with the alumni
- Alumni assist the institution through funds, guidance to maintain the academic quality.
- A Committee deals with alumni related activities.

• Faculty members provide paid/unpaid consultancy in different GOs , and NGOs.

- Census date, Five-Year plans, Reports of various ministries department and commissions.
- Relevant audio-visuals equipment such as overhead projectors, Side Projector, TV., LCD projector and computer are available for use in class, seminar and training programs.
- Computer, internet service are available for students, staff and other users.
- Book Bank facility is available.
