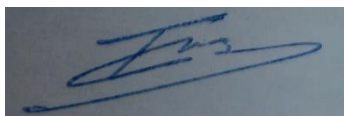

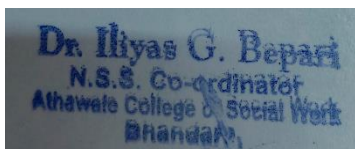

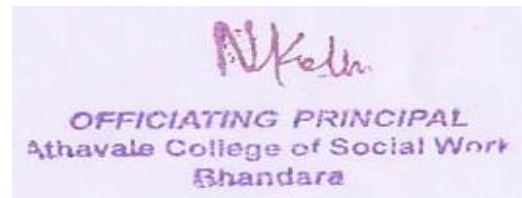

Report

Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University Nagpur Athawale College of Social Work Bhandar National Service Scheme is a unit running since 2nd September 1992. This unit organizes various programs decided by the university including National Youth Day, National Youth week, Republic Day, International Women's Day, N S S Foundation Day, Republic Day, Human Rights Day, Teachers Day, Transport Week, World Population, University Foundation Day thus various types of programs are organized through program national service scheme.

History of National Service Scheme: National Service Scheme was established with the objective of creating social awareness in the minds of college students and bringing about their overall personality development.

National Service Scheme for college students is being implemented under the Ministry of youth welfare and sports Government of India since the centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi's birth i.e. 24th September 1969 in order to coordinate the value of independence character development and social commitment in the new education system.

The concept of starting National Service Scheme is that of Mahatma Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru, a meeting was held in 1950. Based on that, in 1952, in the first five-year plan, it was planned to organize camps for students with more emphasis on social service and manual labor. A plan was suggested. In 1960 Prof.K.G. SalaUddin studied different countries and gave a report on National Service for the youth. In 1964 Dr. Daulat Singh Kothari, the Chairman of the Government of India's Education Reform Commission, in his report recommended the types of programs students should implement for community service. In May 1969, the Vice-Chancellor's Sub- Committee met to draft the National Service Scheme and on 24 September 1969 the then Education Minister Dr. V.K.R.V.Rao announced the launch of the National Service Scheme.

Objectives of National Service Scheme

1. Understanding the society in which we work
2. To qualify oneself to understand the concerned society
3. To know the needs of the society, to understand their problems and to remove them, which will make the society active.
4. Using your education to overcome personal or social problems and find practical Solutions to them.
5. To development a sense of social responsibility within us.
6. To develop in us that quality which is needed to blend in the society.
7. To develop democratic tendencies by possessing leadership qualities
8. Bridging the gap between literate and illiterate
9. To promote and development national unity
10. To awaken the desire to serve the poor sections of the society

Date : 07/02/2024 Wednesday-Advance Committee : On Wednesday 07/02/2024 at 11 am from Athawale college of Social Work Bhandara, we reached Village Wakeshwar District Bhandara to prepare for the camp. First of all, after meeting the village sarpanch and the headmaster, accommodation was arranged in the school for the accommodation of the students. The classrooms were cleaned. 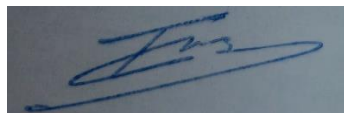
